

BY-LAW NUMBER 572.

By-Law to establish a Public Library in the Town of Aurora, in the County of York, in accordance with the provisions of the "Statutes of Ontario 1920, Chapter 69.

WHEREAS the ^{Aurora} Mechanics' Institute ^{and Library Association} of the Town of Aurora in the County of York, have carried on a public library in the said Town of Aurora, under the provisions of the Act, under which same was incorporated, and the amendments thereto.

AND WHEREAS by Statutes of Ontario, 1920, Chapter 69, Section 10, a library association formed under the "Mechanics' Institute Act" or other former Acts, may, by resolution passed at an annual meeting of the association or a meeting called specially for that purpose, declare it's desire that the library of the association be transferred to a "Public Library Board", appointed in the manner provided by the said Act.

AND WHEREAS by the said Section 10 of the said Act, the necessary by-laws establishing such library need not be submitted to the electors.

AND WHEREAS the ^{Aurora} Mechanics' Institute ^{and Library Association} of the Town of Aurora, conducting a public library, did, at a meeting of it's members specially called for that purpose on the ^{1st} day of December, 1920, pass a resolution declaring it's desire that the library of the association be transferred to a "Public Library Board", copy of such resolution appears as Schedule "A" to this By-Law.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF AURORA, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

Resolution of the Members of the ~~Aurora~~

of the assets of the public Library in the Town of Aurora.

WHEREAS at a meeting of the members of this Association, specially called this *first* day of December, 1920, for the purpose of considering the transfer of the assets of the Aurora public Library to a body corporate, to be known as the "Aurora Public Library Board".

AND WHEREAS by the Statutes of Ontario, 1920, Chapter 69, Section 10, the assets of a library formed under any act relating to the Mechanics' Institute or library associations, may, by resolution passed at an annual meeting of the association or at a meeting specially called for this purpose, declare it's desire that the library of the association be transferred to a public library board.

AND WHEREAS the members of this Association at this meeting called specially for this purpose, deem it expedient and in the interests of the Association and of the Town of Aurora, to transfer the assets of the Aurora public Library, to the "Aurora Public Library Board" to be hereinafter formed as provided by Section 16, Sub-section 1 of this Act.

Griffith*, that we, the members of this Association at this meeting specially called for considering the same, hereby wish to express our desire of transferring our assets to the "Aurora Public Library Board" and we hereby authorize and instruct our trustees to assign and transfer the assets of the Aurora public library to the "Aurora Public Library Board", and we hereby authorize the execution of a deed or transfer by the trustees hereof and authorize and instruct the seal of the Association to be attached to the said transfer.
